2010 Dry Creek Valley Sauvignon Blanc 2 bottles (\$18.00 Retail/\$13.50 Club)

Fresh, crisp flavors of tropical mango, guava, nectarine and honeydew melon are well-balanced to create a wine that is perfect for food pairings such as shrimp cocktail, or fresh summer salads, perhaps with Thai peanut dressing.

The wine unfolds layers of dark chocolate, fresh cracked pepper, raspberry and brown sugar. The mouth is lush, with a rich entry of mixed berries, black currant and wild cherries, coupled with well-knit tannins which provide the perfect balance for the fruit forward Dry Creek hillside distinctive terroir.
